

COLLEGE UNIFORM & PRESENTATION POLICY

This Policy applies to students during college hours, while in transit to and from college, and during their participation in formal College activities outside regular College hours.

We appreciate that the College offers optional clothing items. However, the complete formal uniform is mandatory for specific events, assemblies, photo days, etc., as directed. Optional clothing items are not permissible on these specified occasions. Moreover, the uniform should not be mixed across the 'two seasons' unless otherwise instructed.

- Tuesdays from 8:00 am to 1:00 pm
- Thursdays from 11:00 am to 4:00 pm

The following items, excluding shoes and joggers, should be procured from the Noone Supplier.

SPECIFIC GUIDELINES

- 1. The College reserves the right to modify the College Uniform and Presentation Policy as required.
- 2. Girls' dresses and skirts must be at least knee length.
- 3. College shoes must be a hard leather Black school lace-ups (no buckles, zippers, suede, heels, or sneakers), mandatory for every student from Year 2. Kindergarten and Year 1 students may wear traditional school shoes with Velcro straps if needed (Mary-Jane or doll-style shoes are allowed).
- 4. Plain Sport joggers (without graphics) must have laces, be below ankle height, and may be of any colour (excluding predominantly fluorescent colours). K-2 students may have Velcro fasteners.
- 5. Boys are not obliged to tuck in their summer shirts. Junior girls wearing the optional skort or trousers are not required to tuck in the accompanying top.
- 6. Seniors wear black standard belt.

HAIR MANAGEMENT

- Hair should be clean, well-groomed, and tidy. Hair should not obstruct the face or eyes. For boys, hair
 must be above collar length, while girls with shoulder-length or longer hair must keep all hair fully tied
 back and away from the face/eyes using the optional college hair ties or plain black or grey ribbons, and/
 or headbands.
- Radical hair styles, such as mullet, mohawks, rats' tail is not permitted. Significant variations in hair length are also not acceptable.
- Students with inappropriate hairstyles will be required to comply with this Policy immediately and may not be permitted to attend College. The principal's decision is final regarding this Policy and the students' appearance for the smooth operation of the College.



MISCELLANEOUS – BOYS

- Facial hair should be removed (no moustache, beard, long sideburns, etc.) for a clean-shaven face.
- Boys' of the Sikh religion may wear a black Turban
- No jewellery is allowed except for medical alert necklaces and bangles are not permitted.
- A watch or plain fitness tracker is allowed (without fluorescent colours).

MISCELLANEOUS – GIRLS

- A watch or plain fitness tracker is allowed (without fluorescent colours).
- A single plain flat ring is allowed. No Necklaces (except for medical alerts).
- Earrings should be plain gold or silver stud/small sleeper earrings only (one per ear lobe). No other facial piercings are permitted.
- Makeup, eyelash tinting, acrylic nails, or any other nail products are not allowed. Only clear nail polish may be used.
